We take the worry out of wastewater.

You probably don't think much about what happens to your household's water once you're finished using it. And you shouldn't have to. We collect, clean and discharge household and industrial wastewater every day so you don't have to worry about the process. Your wastewater costs are driven by three main factors:

1. Investment to install pipes.

Wastewater pipe costs more to install because it is bigger and must be laid deeper in the ground so wastewater can flow by gravity to the treatment plant. At some points, pumps must be installed to facilitate the flow.

2. Increasing state and federal standards.

Treatment facilities must be continually upgraded to meet strict federal and state guidelines, as well as the needs of a growing community.

3. Higher costs to treat and transport.

It costs more to treat wastewater than water. A heavy rainfall also can add millions of gallons in the collection system to be treated in a day's time.
