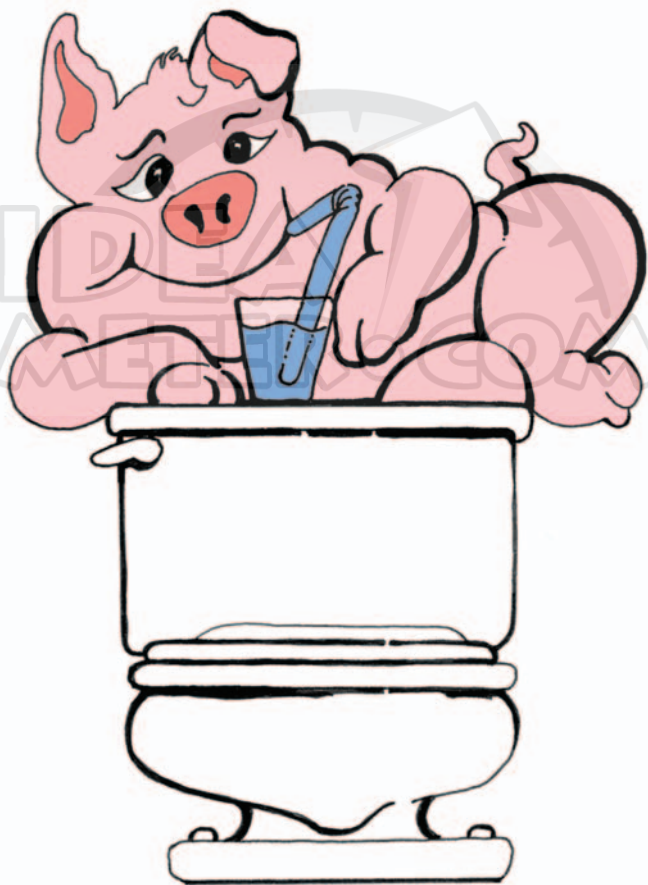


Who's the

It could be your toilet - or any other leak.

Follow these water-saving tips to keep your next water bill down.

- Be a leak seeker and fix all dripping faucets. Check inside your toilet bowl to see if any water is leaving when you're not flushing. A leaking toilet can waste 2,000 to 3,000 gallons of water a month.
- Water your lawn early in the morning or in the cool parts of the day. Using soaker hoses and mulching around plants will help prevent evaporation.
- Wash only full loads in your dishwasher and washing machine.
- Turn off the water as you brush your teeth or shave. Running the water while you shave, for example, uses more water than one person normally drinks in a week.
